After reviewing the minutes of the October 27, 2014 meeting, Terry Baker made a motion to approve the minutes, which is seconded by Mauri Bordner, to accept the minutes as submitted. On the call of the vote, all voted aye.

Park Superintendent Mark Green opened the meeting with an update on the Baseball/Softball programs. Mark stated baseball registration ends on February 28 and softball registration ends on March 14. Green stated the Opening Day Ceremony will be on April 25 for baseball and softball. Mark announced the baseball/softball fundraiser will be a Tin Caps game again this year.

Superintendent Green stated the Father/Daughter Dance was once again a success.
