YOUTH COUNCIL Jackson Longenbaugh, Secretary for the Youth Council, gave an update on their activities.

MAY 8 COUNCIL MEETING Mayor Daniel noted the Council meeting scheduled for May 8 fell on primary election day and the City offices were closed that day. He shared that he and Rosie would like to propose a change to that. He suggested moving it to May 1 or just cancel and have one meeting for the month. Council agreed to cancel the May 8 meetings for Board of Works and City Council.

MAYOR REPORT Mayor Daniel reported they have been holding dispatch interviews, working on a piece of property that could be a potential voluntary annexation, he and Attorney McNagny working on a sewer line issue to determine if it is the City's, City offices closed for Good Friday, he, Rosie Coyle and Troy Gawthrop will be interviewing firms that have submitted bids for the energy savings project for City Hall, they will be holding the preconstruction meeting for the Wooddale project and a 90% design review for the LTCP, the second K9 has been selected; officer and dog were getting ready for the training program.

PARK DEPARTMENT Mark Green reported the Notary Easter egg hunt would be Thursday, opening day for baseball and softball is scheduled for April 21, he gave an update on the aquatics center, park bathrooms will not be opened until freezing temperatures are over.
