After reviewing the minutes of the April 23, 2018 meeting, Roger Ferrell made a motion to approve the minutes, which is seconded by Kim Varga, to accept the minutes as submitted. On the call of the vote, all voted aye.

Mark Green, Park Superintendent, opened with updates on the Aquatics Center. Green stated a lot is going on at the aquatic center with contractors, pool staff, park staff & volunteers to prepare for a soft opening on July 6th 4-8. Opening Day for the public will be July 7th admission will be \$1.00 per person on opening day. Aquatic hours will be 12-7 daily for public. After discussion with park board members, Larry Walter made a motion to eliminate the area as tennis courts and for now look at expanding parking area or pavilion in the future, which is seconded by Mark Ellis.
