The Columbia City Board of Works met in regular session with all members present, Mayor Daniel presiding.

**MINUTES** Motion was made by Weigold to approve an overview of the December 10, 2013 meeting minutes as presented, Crowder seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**FIRE DEPARTMENT AGREEMENT 2014** Tom LaRue advised there were no changes from previous years.

Motion was made by Crowder to enter into the agreement for 2014 with the Columbia City Volunteer Fire Department as written, Weigold seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**NEW POLICE SERGEANT RECOMMENDATION** Tim Longenbaugh explained they interviewed 3 candidates and was the recommendation to make Scott Leatherman the new police sergeant.

Motion was made by Mayor Daniel to approve, based on the Chief and Committee's recommendation, to promote Scott Leatherman to Sergeant, Weigold seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**DRAIN COLLECTION – COUNTY** Mayor Daniel advised the collection could be done by assessing individually by the County to the property owners or the Storm Water department could pay the fees for our City residents. He shared that last year it was approved to have the Storm Water utility pay for the drainage improvement fees for our residents.

Dan Weigold reviewed the list of parcels that would be collected for 2014 for an amount of \$13,113.12. He explained of that amount \$272.84 was for road right of ways that we would have to pay either way.

Walt Crowder questioned if there was a legal document that needed to be on file listing the ditches. Mayor Daniel felt it might be good to have a follow up sheet listing the ones we were paying for and their location. Dan Weigold advised he could have Brandon Forrester put something together that could be attached to the minutes.

Motion was made by Weigold to pay the drainage assessment to the County in the amount of \$13,113.12, Mayor Daniel seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**BILLS** Motion was made by Weigold to pay the bills as presented in the amount of \$747,056.02, Crowder seconded the motion, all voted aye.

**YOUTH COUNCIL** Gabby Anglin was present representing the Youth Council. She advised they adopted a family for Christmas which they provided a meal and presents for. Mayor Daniel noted that the Youth Council members donated their own money for this.

Having no further business to come before the Board the meeting was adjourned.
