The Columbia City Board of Works met in regular session with all members present, Mayor Daniel presiding.

MINUTES Motion was made by Weigold to approve an overview of the July 14, 2015 meeting minutes as presented, Weigold and Crowder voted aye, Mayor Daniel abstained.

BID OPENING: SUBSTATION Rosie Coyle opened and read bids received from Hooper Corporation in the amount of \$275,300.00 and Vaughn Industries in the amount of \$125,000.00.

Bids were taken under advisement until the next meeting.

STREET CLOSING CHANGE: WHITLEY COUNTY AUTUMN ART FESTIVAL Jeff Walker explained they were originally looking at closure of a single day but there have been some changes to the festival events and requested permission to close at 6 p.m. on Friday evening rather than early Saturday morning. He advised everything else would be the same except for the half block of North Chauncey Street where the stage will be; they cannot get the stage removed Saturday night so that portion will be later.

Motion was made by Weigold to approve the street closing for Friday, September 11 at 6 p.m. until Saturday, September 12 at 11 p.m. with the extended closure as defined, Mayor Daniel seconded the motion, all voted aye.

TRICK-OR-TREAT Mayor Daniel announced Trick-or-Treat will be on Saturday, October 31 from 6 – 8 p.m.

BILLS Motion was made by Weigold to approve the bills as presented in the amount of \$967,162.90, Crowder seconded the motion, all voted aye.
