The Columbia City Board of Works met in regular session with all members present, Mayor Daniel presiding.

MINUTES Motion was made by Weigold to approve an overview of the June 28, 2016 meeting minutes as presented, Crowder seconded the motion, all voted aye.

STREET CLOSING PERMIT – INTIMIDATOR 5K Tom LaRue explained this was a scholarship fundraiser in remembrance of Tim Hearld who was very active in our community. He explained the route of the run and requested to have an officer to help runners cross Van Buren Street. He shared this year they would like to make it a color run which is where they throw color on the participants.

Mayor Daniel advised he did not have a problem with them having a color run but stressed that they needed to be very careful they designate runners who are a part of the 5K and those who are not. Chief Hively expressed a concern that it would create traffic hazards unless they would do the color somewhere other than where cars would be traveling. Mayor Daniel questioned if they could designate a certain part of the run that would be the color run areas. Chief LaRue suggested they restrict the color portion to the high school property. Mayor Daniel advised he would be in favor of that but to get permission from the high school.

Motion was made by Mayor Daniel to approve the street closing permit request for August 6 from 8 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. with the caveat that the color run portion must stay on school property with their permission, Crowder seconded the motion, all voted aye.

STREET CLOSING PERMIT – MOVIE ON THE SQUARE 2016 Mayor Daniel reported they were planning to have the event at 7:30 p.m. on August 26. He stated they would like to close down Chauncey Street from West Van Buren to Market Street but the police would still have access to their parking. He advised they would like the streets closed from 7 p.m. – 10 p.m. and would like to also request the street lamps around the courthouse square be turned off during that time if possible.

Motion was made by Weigold to approve the Movie on the Square 2016 for August 26, 2016 from 7 p.m. – 10 p.m., Crowder seconded the motion, Weigold and Crowder voted aye, Mayor Daniel abstained.

BILLS Motion was made by Weigold to pay the bills as presented in the amount of \$699,499.38, Mayor Daniel seconded the motion, all voted aye.

RUNNING AROUND SCREEN PRINTING – PARKING SPACE REQUEST
Rosie Coyle presented a request from Jo Ann Bird to use some of the parking spaces or sidewalk area to put a lift so that they could paint their building at 227 W. Van Buren St. this Saturday and Sunday.

Kelly Cearbaugh advised he talked with her and felt all of the parking spaces would need to be shut down because of the overspray.

Mayor Daniel advised he did not have a problem with it; they were trying to improve the building.

Motion was made by Mayor Daniel to approve the parking space closure for the morning of July 16 until the evening of July 17 for JoAnn Bird with the caveat that the spaces need to be roped off with a clear pedestrian route out and around the lift, Weigold seconded the motion, all voted aye.

Chief Hively advised he would contact Jo Ann.

Having no further business to discuss the meeting was adjourned.
