



- Children 12 & under must be accompanied by an adult (Adult is 18 and older)
- Everyone entering the facility must pay – even if you do not plan to swim
- No toys or floating devices permitted
- No outside food, drinks, or gum may be brought into the facility. No breakable containers will be permitted in the aquatics center.
- No smoking, alcohol, or drugs on the premises
- There will be a 10 minute rest period every hour
- Regulation bathing suits must be worn
- All persons shall take a cleansing shower before using the pool. A person leaving the pool to use the toilet shall take another cleansing shower before returning to the pool
- No running or rough play is permitted in the pool, the deck, diving board, on floats on platforms, in dressing rooms or in the showers
- Food purchased within the facility must not be brought onto the pool deck
- Spitting, spouting of water, blowing the nose and similar behavior in the pool is prohibited

- Anyone who has or has had diarrhea in the past two (2) weeks shall not use the pool
- Anyone who has an area of exposed sub epidermal tissue, open blisters, cuts, etc. is advised not to use the pool
- All diaper aged children must use plastic pants with tight fitting elastic at the legs and waist, or use swim diapers
- Do not change diapers at poolside
- No inappropriate language or behaviors will be tolerated. You will be asked to leave the premises
- The Russel and Evelyn Aquatic Center employees are not responsible for property loss or bathing suit damage while in the park.
- Any locks left on lockers for more than three (3) days will be cut off by pool staff
- There will be no refunds given due to inclement weather. A “re-entry” pass, good for only that day, will be given if weather and conditions promise to improve
- OBEY LIFEGUARDS AT ALL TIMES
- The City of Columbia City reserves the right to eject from, or refuse admittance, to the facility for any patron who is found violating the rules. **No refunds will be given.**
