ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 15

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA CITY AND REPEALING ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia City ("City") has heretofore constructed and has in operation a municipal waterworks; and

WHEREAS, the City has caused a financial study of the Columbia City municipal waterworks to be made by O.W. Krohn & Associates, LLP, Westfield, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the study indicates that the current rates and charges are not sufficient to meet the reasonable financial requirements of the utility; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council finds that the proposed rates and charges for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks of the City are estimated to be sufficient to enable the City to properly operate and maintain its waterworks plant, to provide for depreciation, to pay debt service on indebtedness of the waterworks and to maintain a debt service reserve and the proposed rates and charges should be enacted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA CITY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. There shall be and are hereby established the water rates and charges, based on the use of water supplied by said waterworks, as set forth on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. The rates and charges shall become effective upon proper publication, completion of the public hearing, confirmation of written notice to outside users and the approval of the Common Council of the proposed rates and charges set forth on Appendix A. If the schedule of rates and charges herein set out shall be adjusted in accordance with the proceedings before, such rates and charges, as adjusted, shall become effective without further action of the Common Council. Such adjusted rates and charges shall be implemented in the next billing cycle of the utility.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
