

§ 51.34 ONE-TIME CONNECTION CHARGES (TAP FEES).

(A) The one-time connection charges (commonly referred to by the city as tap fees) to be paid by each user shall be based upon the meter size and charged as follows:

<i>Meter Sizes (Inches)</i>	<i>One-Time Connection Charges</i>
5/8 - 3/4	\$ 1,000
1	2,250
1-1/2	4,000
2	6,000
3	13,000
4	22,000

(B) The Board of Public Works and Safety may, by resolution, and as it may feel necessary from time to time, amend the one-time connection charge to be charged for each individual sewer tap based upon the considerations and requirements as set forth in I.C. 36-9-23-25 and I.C. 36-9-23-26, as the same maybe amended from time to time.

(C) Rates and charges incurred under this section shall be prepared and collected by the city in accordance with those provisions regulating the preparation and issuance of bills for sewer service generally. The monies collected under this section shall be deposited in the Stormwater Revenue Fund.
