The Columbia City Common Council met in regular session with all members except Dan Weigold present, Mayor Daniel presiding.

<u>PUBLIC HEARING: 2023 BUDGET</u> Mayor Daniel explained there was not many changes to the budget for 2023. He noted we were potentially planning to add an additional firefighter, employees were given a minor wage increase, there were equipment purchases, but in general the structure of our budget has not changed from the previous year.
