A Resolution of Support for a Food and Beverage Tax for the Funding of Eagle Park

WHEREAS:

The City of Columbia City has undertaken the construction of a new park, known as

Eagle Park, located on North Whitley Street between North Street and Collinwood

Ave; and

WHEREAS:

The Common Council, Mayor, and Clerk-Treasurer have found it prudent and

necessary to consider different funding options for future construction phases of

Eagle Park; and

WHEREAS:

The Food and Beverage Tax is a legislatively granted, locally approved funding

mechanism that captures up to 1% of sales receipts on prepared food and beverages

within the corporate limits of the municipality; and

WHEREAS:

The Whitley County Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center, Columbia City

Connect (the Indiana Main Street organization), as well as numerous local

restauranteurs have signed a petition of support for this action.

NOW THEREFORE:

The Common Council of the City of Columbia City, with the support of the Mayor

and Clerk-Treasurer, do hereby urge and encourage the Indiana General Assembly to

allow the City of Columbia City to pass a 1% Food and Beverage Tax for the

purposes of funding construction at Eagle Park.

Further, the Common Council, Mayor, and Clerk-Treasurer commits to transparency

and public input in the adoption phase, while encouraging and supporting a sunset of

20 years for this tax.
